RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS OF USE OF FACILITIES
INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

By order of the Board of Trustees, all organizations or individuals requesting use of district facilities shall provide verification of liability insurance prior to using those facilities.

The district's liability insurance does not extend coverage to persons/groups other than the district's Board of Trustees, employees, agents, and volunteers who are engaged in official district activities.

The insurance certificate must include:

- 1. Certificate Holder: Mountain View-Los Altos Union High School District
2. An Additional Insured Endorsement to the policy naming the "Mountain View-Los Altos Union High School District, its Board of Trustees, employees, agents, and volunteers as additional insured" and the endorsement shall state "the district's insurance shall be considered excess insurance and will not respond until all primary insurance has been exhausted." This must be a separate endorsement page.

Minimum limits of liability per occurrence:

Liability exposure may range from a low level (such as a community advisory council meeting) to a high level (such as a carnival). The district reserves the right to determine the limits of liability required.

Table with 2 columns: Activity Level and Occurrence Limit. Rows include: No physical activity involved and/or small group (\$500,000), Physical activity involved and/or medium-size group (\$1,000,000), High risk activity and/or large group (\$3,000,000).

If a general aggregate limit applies, the general aggregate limit shall be twice the required occurrence limit.

For some persons or very small groups whose activities in district facilities will entail a very low level of risk, the district may, at its discretion, allow substitution of a waiver of liability and hold harmless signed by each participant in the activity.
